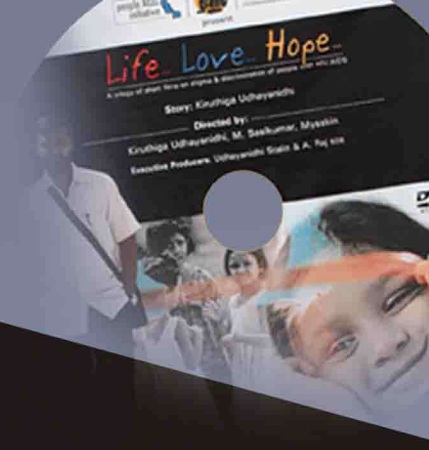


Ace Film Director Mysskin at Don Bosco MEDIA
